Professor Ken Wilson

is Professor of Old Age Psychiatry at the University of Liverpool. Throughout his working life he has had an interest in innovative service development, working for patients that otherwise do not routinely fit with service provision or models. He was a lead participant in developing national services for working age adults suffering from dementia at the time when they were not catered for by older people's services. It is through this clinical work that the local early onset dementia team developed experience in rehabilitation of younger people with alcohol related brain damage and subsequently got commissioned provision. Professor Wilson's major research interest lies in depression in older people and the physically frail. He is interested in epidemiology, clinical trials, and systematic reviews. He is currently engaged in research in mood disturbance in Parkinson's disease and has recently undertaken a trial in the treatment of depression in dementia. He has been a Medical Director of a mental health trust and now Clinical Director of Cheshire and Merseyside Comprehensive Research Network.
